SCHEDULE TIPS AND CRITERIA FOR ENTERING 2021 SHOW

1. ANY STEM CAN ONLY BE ENTERED ONCE IN A SHOW
2. PHOTOGRAPHS MAY NOT BE ENHANCED
3. IMAGE SHOULD "FILL THE FRAME"
4. PHOTOGRAPHS DO NOT HAVE TO BE TAKEN BY THE EXHIBITOR
5. CELL PHONE CAMERAS MAY BE USED. AN APPLE IPHONE OF 8 OR HIGHER WILL PRODUCE A HIGHER QUALITY RESULT
6. USE A PIN HOLDER (FROG) OR BOTTLE FOR EXHIBIT
7. TRIFOLD PROJECT BOARDS ARE PERFECT FOR A BACKGROUND AND MATCHING POSTER BOARD FOR A SOLID SURFACE (STAPLES, OFFICE DEPOT). WE RECOMMEND 'WHITE' AS THE UNIFORM COLOR THAT IMPROVES PRESENTATION OF SHOW ENTRIES DURING JUDGING.
8. MASKING TAPE WITH INCHES STAMPED ON IT SHOULD BE TAPED TO A BACK CORNER OF THE TRIFOLD FOR ENTRY SIZE....ACROSS THE BACK ALSO FOR WIDTH IF NEEDED. (STAPLES)
9. USE UNIFORM LIGHTING, AVOID SHADOWS...KEEP THE LIGHT BEHIND YOU. SHOOT AT EYE LEVEL, STRAIGHT ON SHOWING MEASUREMENTS, ANOTHER PHOTO WITH CLOSE-UP OF LILY BLOOM (WITH OR WITHOUT MEASURING TAPE) -- 2 PHOTOS FOR EACH ENTRY
10. ADDITIONAL PHOTOGRAPH OR EXHIBITOR STANDING NEXT TO ENTRY (COULD BE USED IN THE FINAL FLOWER SHOW PRODUCTION OR AWARDS)
11. CONSIDER REQUESTING 360 DEGREE VIDEO FOR SEEDLINGS. COULD PLACE ENTRY ON AN INEXPENSIVE PLASTIC TURNTABLE IN FRONT OF TRIFOLD TO EXECUTE IMAGE.
12. DO NOT SPRAY WATER ON BLOOMS BEFORE PHOTOGRAPHING. IF PHOTOGRAPH IS EXPANDED FOR JUDGING...DROPLETS SHOW LIKE A FLAW
13. CUT LILY STEM 1/3-1/2 IN LENGTH TO EXHIBIT INFLORESCENCE AND FOLIAGE, LEAVING 1/2 WITH FOLIAGE TO FEED THE BULB.



14. STEMS HAVE TO BE CUT AND DATED

15. A **NOVICE** IS A PERSON WHO HAS NOT ENTERED A LILY STEM IN THE HORTICULTURE DIVISION OF A NORTH AMERICAN LILY SOCIETY ACCREDITED SHOW.

SECTION B

THREE STEM COLLECTIONS

Each entry consists of three stems - each stem in a separate container and named.

19. Three stems of the same named hybrid clone, strain or hybrid group or species.
20. Collection of three different hybrids from the same division or species, each

stem named or # if a seedling

21. Collection of three stems, each stem from a different division of the Horticultural Classification. Each stem must be named or # if a seedling

SECTION C

SINGLE STEMS OF NAMED STRAINS, GREXES OR HYBRID GROUPS AND UNNAMED HYBRIDS NOT GROWN FROM SEED BY

THE EXHIBITOR An exhibitor may make more than one entry in a class provided each entry is a different variety or hybrid.
